CREW PROCEDURES FOR THE ROAD

General:

Crew please stay together, be under control and know where crew members are at all times.

Uniform:

Complete Field Uniform – Scout Shirt, Scout pants (zip offs), Scout belt, Scout socks, Contingent neckerchief, Crew hat and Hiking boots worn:

- On the plane and while in airports
- At All meals while traveling
- When in public

Activity:

Contingent T-shirt, Scout shorts, Scout belt, Scout socks, Sneakers and Crew hat.

Cargo Sacks:

Traveling to Philmont: Identify with scout's name, contingent and crew numbers and phone number.

Traveling from Philmont: Identify with scout's name, home address and phone number.

Plane:

Each Crew Advisor is responsible for ensuring that their crew is on time for ALL flights.

*****ALL KNIVES WILL BE IN THE BACKPACKS BEFORE BOARDING!****

- Use bathrooms sparingly.
- First row seats will be reserved for the Bus Captain.
- NO One leaves the bus without the Bus Captain' knowledge.
- Please keep the noise to a minimum, as it is disturbing to the bus driver.
- Everyone is in Full Field Uniform at ALL Meals.
- Casual dress on the bus; Full Field Uniform when leaving the bus.
- Adult Advisors **ALWAYS** eat first. (They need more time to digest their food)
- Crew Leader is **Responsible** for the crew at all time.

- Full Scout Field Uniform will be worn when traveling
- Only fully trained Adult Advisors (anyone 18 or older) will be invited
- There will be NO use of Tobacco Products by anyone under 18 years of age.

- There will be NO Drinking of Alcoholic Beverages when engaged in Boy Scout Activities.
- There will be NO using of Illegal Drugs by anyone at any time.
- There must always be Two Deep Leadership
- All medication is to be turned into the Adult Advisor responsible for same.

Hints for a Great Vacation:

- When Traveling Always use the Buddy System in Airports, Bus Terminals, or other Public Places.
- Ask for and keep receipts for ALL your purchases.
- Mark ALL your things. (most of our stuff looks alike)
- Tell your Advisor and other Crew Members where you are going at all times.
- Go into another scout's tent only if you are invited.
- Live by the Scout Oath & the Scout Law.
